- ❖ Syllabus Outline: Pruning presentation, hands on training for selective pruning of groundcover, perennials, shrubs and small trees, hedge trimming of shrubs, overhead pruning of trees and palms, tool sharpening techniques, cleaning and storing of tools, proper safety procedures and use of personal protective equipment. Chain saw operation is not part of this course syllabus. Brief question and answer session.

## **2. Irrigation Hydraulics, Design and Troubleshooting – August 29 (Sat.) – Lynnett Tohara (Diamond Sprinkler)**

- ❖ Syllabus Outline: Hydraulics and Design; water pressure and elevation changes, elements of an irrigation plan, point of connection, backflow prevention devices, mainline, sleeves, quick couplers, valve types, laterals, flow rates, friction loss, precipitation rates, selection of sprinkler heads and spacing.
